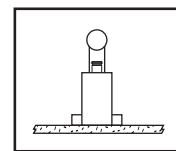
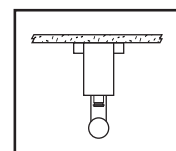


Lampholders mounted to a horizontal surface may be used with almost any shape of lamp: straight, bent, curved, or free-form. The examples shown below depict how this mounting arrangement can be used.

Lampholder mounted to a horizontal surface facing upward



Lampholder mounted to a horizontal surface facing downward

<p>NO</p>	<p>Even though this curved lamp is mounted to what could be interpreted as a horizontal surface, this configuration is prohibited because the curvature of the lamp is not flat to the mounting plane of the lampholders.* The example shown to the right is an acceptable alternative (using a vertical mounting surface) to achieve the same lighting effect.</p> <p><i>*Exception: If lamp radius is greater than 75 feet (23 meters), this mounting arrangement may be used (circular or semicircular installations using surface-mounted lampholders only).
